# Detailed description of the implementation of these four procedures (investigator triangulation, audit trail, referential adequacy, and exemplar identification):

## 1. Investigator Triangulation

This involves using multiple researchers to review and analyze the data to ensure the findings are not based on one person's bias or subjective interpretation. In our research, the first author conducted the initial analysis, identifying and naming themes from CTM output. The second author then independently reviewed the same CTM topics, and the proposed themes. The two

researchers then met to compare their interpretations, discuss any disagreements, and reach a consensus on the final theme definitions and frame categorizations.

#### 2. Audit Trail

It involves creating a detailed record of the entire research process. In practice, we maintained a comprehensive audit trail consisting of 1) the raw data collected by the Python crawlers. 2) the code and parameters used for the CTM topic modeling. 3) notes from the data familiarization phase. 4) a log of our analytical decisions, including how we moved from the raw CTM topics to the defined themes, and from the themes to the final frames. This includes the "supplementary file" mentioned in the manuscript, which shows the direct link between CTM keywords and our defined themes.

## 3. Referential Adequacy

It involves archiving a portion of the raw data so that it can be re-examined later to support the findings. During our research, we have archived the full datasets of all collected posts, comments and reposts. Throughout the writing process, when describing a particular frame, we repeatedly returned to this raw data archive to ensure our descriptions were accurate and well-supported by the actual content of the Weibo posts.

### 4. Exemplar Identification

It refers to the process of selecting clear, and representative examples from the data. In presenting our findings, we selected some examples of Weibo posts to represent the frames being described.
