- 2) "How satisfied are you with how democracy is working in the UK as a whole?"; answers: very dissatisfied, rather dissatisfied, rather satisfied, very satisfied
- 3) "People like me have no control over what the government does anyway"; answers: Strongly disagree, somewhat disagree, somewhat agree, strongly agree

- 19) <u>Social dominance orientation:</u> "We should do what we can to make conditions more equal for different groups in society"; "Equality between different groups in society should be our ideal"; "Some groups of people are just more worthy than others"; "Inferior groups should stay in their place"; Answers: Scale between 1=strongly disagree and 7=strongly agree
- 20) <u>Narcissism:</u> "I deserve to be seen as a great personality", "Being a very special person gives me a lot of strength", "I manage to be the centre of attention because of my outstanding contributions", "Most people are somehow losers", "I want my rivals to fail", "I get annoyed if another person steals the show from me"; answers: scale between 1=strongly disagree and 6=strongly agree
- 21) <u>Sadism:</u> "Hurting people would be exciting"; "People would enjoy hurting others if they gave it a try"; "I have sometimes hurt other people because I was able to"; "I've humiliated others to keep them in line";
